### 1.3 Broadcaster

Sky Sports will be the host broadcaster for the Tournament and have committed to live broadcast of at least seven matches. Other matches may be sold to nations competing for their own consumption.

### 1.4 Tickets

Tickets for the WRWC 2010 will be available in March exclusively through Ticketmaster. Never before has a ticketing service been brought on board for a Women's Rugby World Cup, with tickets previously being distributed through the host union and host venues.

In another exciting link-up rugby ***fans who buy tickets for the WRWC 2010 will automatically be put on a priority ticketing list for the 2015 Rugby World Cup*** in England.
