MINI & YOUTH PLAYER REGISTRATION

ACTION REQUIRED BY 1 OCTOBER 2010

Player Registration is an essential tool for the delivery of **mini and youth rugby** across the country.

It allows clubs to record and monitor their participants and ensure compliance of playing within the correct age grade.

To help deliver all aspects of mini and youth rugby it is important that the Player Registration System contains the most up to date player records.

This summer the RFU changed its regulations, making it mandatory for every age grade club player (U7 – U18) to be registered on Rugby First within 45 days of joining the club. This can be done online by Clubs through Rugby First. To assist in making the registration lists more accurate, listing only your active participants, we will require you to re-register all of those players you wish to keep registered while removing those who have left the club or no longer play.

Adult player registration successfully undertook a similar re-registration process this summer.

ALL clubs must “re-register” between **1st September 2010 and 1st October 2010**. If this process is not completed, those players not “re-registered” shall become de-registered on 2nd October 2010.

This process has been designed to be as easy as possible through either RugbyFirst (online) or by paper via your Constituent Body registrars and we are providing support for those who are struggling to make this happen by calling or emailing our support team (details shown at the bottom of each page).

The online process is outlined below with guidance notes.
